UPDATES

- **Pedestrian Plan** Much progress has been made. Details can be found at LawrenceKs.org. It is in the public engagement period. Progress includes reducing speed limit to 25 mph in neighborhoods and collecting data for next phase, which includes sidewalks (quality, gaps in distribution and quality) ADA and land use code. Some challenges are presented by homeowners due to overhanging trees, grass cuttings, vehicles on sidewalks, etc. Education of the homeowner is important.
- **Donation Drive.** The PNA neighborhood provided excellent response to the elementary school's needs with items through the drop off and on the Amazon wish list.
